- Annalisa Casaflo observes in her essay "No More Yielding than a Dream": The Construction of Shakespeare in "The Sandman"
- "... Shakespeare... can be understood. Critics can keep re-reading Shakespeare to suit its ends, all the while pretending nothing has changed. Shakespeare's very fluidity has led him to become, in essence, his own subject... the very idea of Shakespeare as a person circulates as freely as his texts... familiarity with Shakespeare's works includes a familiarity with Shakespeare himself, but... that familiarity is more often with the cultural dream of Shakespeare than with the reality... Shakespeare is rarely presented as simply a writer. Rather he is shaped and interpreted by cultural forces, so he is always modern but always eternal. His personality can become a representation of some key cultural issue or another another writer's vision of self" (95)
