- The assets created as a result of execution of any scheme under BEUP will be maintained by the institution for 10. whose benefit or through whom public utility is created or the institution which already owns the asset to which further development is made and to other cases where no such institution exists the appropriate tier or Panchayat or the Municipal Body under whose jurisdiction such asset is created.
- Activities under the sanctioned schemes would be subject to normal audit scrutiny and financial procedure of 11. Govt. of West Bengal

12. (a) The State Govt. shall always and be the absolute owner of the durable asset created out of the BEUP funds.

(b) The land and immovable property offered by the beneficiary/Organization viz. Society or Trusty for executing the developmental work must be free any encumbrances, free from pending and are not affected by the urban land (ceiling and regulation) Act 1976.

(c) The assets created by utilizing BEUP fund, should not be used for commercial purpose/handed over to other person or office organization.

(d) Plaque showing details of the scheme (order of ACS, Deptt. of Planning vide No.186-ACS/OOPSPM/2018 dt.13/09/2018) to be affixed prominently on the body of assets created under BEUP.

(e) For all other issues strict adherence to the provisions framed in relevant G.O. Circular etc. must be carried out.
